

# Can't Conceive ?

Infertility is the inability to conceive after one year of unprotected sexual intercourse or carry a pregnancy to term. It can be caused by a variety of factors and affects both men and women.

If you are struggling to conceive, it is important to seek support from a medical professional.



Your doctor can help you to identify the underlying issues and explore treatment options. In some cases, assisted reproductive technology (ART) may be recommended.

Locally, The ART clinic at Mater Dei Hospital provides assistance for couples struggling with infertility to achieve pregnancy or live births through various treatments and procedures.

Prospective parents are first referred to the clinic by their obstetrician. Once referred, a preliminary consultation is held with the ART medical team. A number of investigations are performed, and the couple is then followed by the medical team. Prospective parents are then referred for different treatments according to the results obtained from the investigations.
