YOU MUST RESERVE USING THE ACS-EVENT-SPECIFIC WEBSITE IN ORDER TO GAIN THE DISCOUNTED \$15 DAILY RESORT FEE!** Resort Fee includes: Wifi; self parking; 2 bottles of water per day; 2 for 1 frozen drinks at Tropicana Pool; 20% off Trips at Zero1 Off Road Adventures; 20% off Grand Canyon Tours; Glow Spa- \$30 off services over \$140, 20% off retail products. **[We recommend all attendees make their reservations prior to January 30, 2021!] “EARLY-BIRD” DISCOUNTED ENTRY FEE: If you postmark any entry fees by January 30, 2021, pay the 20% discounted entry fee stated on the front of this entry form.** Entry fees on the entry form in the “YES” column reflect 20% discount **AFTER** the \$75-\$125 deduction for staying at the Tropicana and deducting greens fees. “Early-Bird” discount % if you are NOT staying at the Tropicana is slightly less.
- \$25 is deducted from each Team entry fee towards a Registration Fee.

PAYMENT INFORMATION: Enclose entry fee with form. All fees must be in U.S. dollars. Postmark your entry by Monday, March 22, 2021, to qualify for the Standard Entry Fee. Between March 23 and April 5, 2021, pay the Late Entry Fee. Late entries must be paid in US funds by cashier’s check, traveler’s check, money order, credit card, PayPal or online. Credit card and PayPal payments will be assessed an additional 5% (7% if Canadian entry) merchant finance fee. No personal, business or league checks will be accepted for entries postmarked after March 22, 2021. No entries postmarked after April 5, 2021 will be accepted. No exceptions! Take advantage of the **“EARLY BIRD” ENTRY FEE for 2021 if postmarked or online by January 30, 2021 !**

ELIGIBILITY

MASTER/ ADVANCED PLAYER: Any player listed on any state or national Advanced, Intermediate or Masters lists, incl. VNEA and BCAPL...or “Known Ability” with skills commensurate with players on these lists. Professional players are not eligible. (see tourney guidelines)

OPEN PLAYER: Any player who does not meet “Advanced Player” guidelines and who averages an “8” or “9” in a league that uses the 10-point scoring system or the equivalent if using other scoring systems - an average or above-average player in most leagues.

STANDARD PLAYER: Any player who does not meet “Open or Advanced Player” guidelines and who averages a “7” or below in a league that uses the 10-point scoring system or the equivalent if using other scoring systems – a below-average player in most leagues.

All Men’s/Mixed 8-Ball teams are 5-person teams (3-person if 9-Ball) and may have up to 10 players (6 players if 9-Ball) on the roster. All Women’s 8-Ball teams are 4-person teams (3-person if 9-Ball) and may have up to 7 players (6 players if 9-Ball) on the roster. All players must have played a minimum of eight (8) full matches over a minimum of eight (8) weeks during a sanctioned session in the same ACS/CCS-sanctioned league since June 1, 2020, and meet ACS amateur requirements. **IMPORTANT! ALL TEAMS IN ALL DIVISIONS MAY BE COMPOSED OF ANY QUALIFIED PLAYERS FROM THEIR LOCAL LEAGUE OPERATOR’S SYSTEM** (exception: Advanced Teams).

8-Ball:

- **5-person Men’s/Mixed Standard Teams and 4-person Women’s Standard Teams** may contain a maximum of one (1) Open player on roster and NO Advanced or Masters!
- **5-person Men’s/Mixed Open Teams and 4-person Women’s Open Teams** may contain a maximum of one (1) Advanced or Master player on roster.
- **5-person Men’s Advanced Teams and 4-person Women’s Advanced Teams** must enter these respective divisions if the team roster contains more than one (1) (no minimum) ACS Advanced or Master, State Masters on ANY list, VNEA Intermediate or Master or BCAPL Advanced or Master on its roster; and - **IMPORTANT!** - may consist of any qualified players from ANY ACS/CCS/MPA leagues (can be from more than one) based within the same state or province!

9-Ball:

- **3-person Men’s/Mixed Standard Teams** may contain a maximum of one (1) Open player on roster and NO Advanced or Masters!
- **3-person Men’s/Mixed Open Teams** must contain no Advanced or Master player on roster.
- **3-person Women’s Open Teams** may contain a maximum of one (1) Advanced or Master-rated player on roster.
- **3-person Men’s Advanced Teams and Women’s Advanced teams** must enter these respective divisions if the team roster contains more than one (1) (no minimum) ACS Advanced or Master, State Masters on ANY list, VNEA Intermediate or Master or BCAPL Advanced or Master on its roster; and **IMPORTANT!** - may consist of any qualified players from ANY ACS/CCS/MPA leagues (can be from more than one) based within the same state or province!

There are NO minimum or maximum age requirements to enter. DRESS CODE: Matching collared shirts REQUIRED. See DRESS CODE details at www.americancuesports.org. ACS NATIONALS IS A NON-SMOKING EVENT!

CHECK – IN: A representative of the team is required to check-in onsite at the ACS registration desk to collect their tournament “goodie bags” and confirm their final “official” roster. The official roster of players will appear on every score sheet during play.
