Please comply with the following process.

Tournament Entry Details/Process:

- To receive the "Early Entry", players need to turn in their entry forms and money to their local League Operator. The League Operators need to email the singles/team entry forms to Jodi Hirning by February 18th. - Those who show up the day of the tournament without prior notice, given to Jodi Hirning by February 18th, will be charged the ON-SITE late fee of \$10.00 plus entry.

Rules of this tournament:

- 1) All monies (minus the registration) will be paid back to players.
- 2) Table fee of \$1.00 paid by person racking. Is now \$10 Green Fees Per event.
- 3) ACS National Tournament rules will apply to this tournament; 45 seconds per shot.
- 4) Double elimination (race for losing side will depend on # on entries).
- 5) Rack and Break your own.
- 6) Singles: Flip for the first break, then alternate; Teams: Follow score sheet for breaking
- 7) 8-BALL on the break is NOT a win. Scratch on 8-Ball is not a loss as long as the 8-Ball stays on the table.
- 8) NO PHONE CALLS or TEXTING during your game.
- 9) NO headsets.
- 10) All matches are to be played if you do not play you forfeit your spot (NO splitting the money).
