MUST-TRY RESTAURANTS

DELILAH AT WYNN LAS VEGAS

PETER LUGER STEAK HOUSE AT CAESARS PALACE

Enjoy the stellar service and prime cuts this American institution has been offering for over a century. You'll feel right at home in the restaurant's German beer hall setting while enjoying its signature dry-aged steaks and top-shelf classic cocktails. Don't forget an order of Luger's Sizzling Bacon to start.



ESTHER'S KITCHEN

This very in-demand spot (note the lines outside the doors on any given night) in the vibrant Arts District is helmed by acclaimed chef James Trees, whose culinary influence is pervasive in Las Vegas and was once tapped by celebrity chef Gordon Ramsay. The seasonal-forward menu includes fresh-made pastas, flavor-bursting salads and a cocktail menu made with ingredients that will blow your mind (and flavor palate).

ORLA AT MANDALAY BAY RESORT & CASINO

Michael Mina has hit culinary gold in Las Vegas yet again with his new restaurant focused on Mediterranean cuisine. The menu was inspired by his childhood, evoking the essence of the region's vibrant markets and bazaars. Every bite will transport you, from the spicy marinated red snapper to the black harissa-grilled lamb chops.

MOTHER WOLF AT FONTAINEBLEAU LAS VEGAS

James Beard Award-winning chef Evan Funke has opened his first restaurant outside California. He offers a traditional approach to Roman cuisine, with pizzas and pastas making the menu alongside classic dishes like grilled whole branzino and fettucine with prosciutto and white truffle.



GJELINA AT THE VENETIAN RESORT LAS VEGAS

Gjelina Las Vegas marks the third outpost of this acclaimed restaurant and showcases a menu of seasonal, produce-driven dishes built alongside a strong foundation of family.

MUST-DO ACTIVITIES AND ATTRACTIONS

Las Vegas has something to experience around the clock, 365 days a year. From zip lining in the heart of Downtown Las Vegas to fabulous dancing fountains, there's no shortage of attractions for everyone to enjoy. And, of course, no place delivers more world-class entertainment. Be sure to add some of these options to your itinerary!

SPHERE

The largest spherical structure in the world — visible from space — this next-generation entertainment venue provides stunning visuals on its exterior completely covered in LED screens. Inside, your senses will be awakened with its multisensory 4D technology, whether at a concert or enjoying Darren Aronofsky's *Postcard from Earth*, a film made for its unique capabilities.



ARTE MUSEUM

From strolling beautiful beaches to admiring the aurora borealis and more, this uniquely immersive exhibition reinterprets various aspects of nature and art by using digital technology to create different zones that immerse you into works of stunning beauty and powerful elements of nature.

PLAY PLAYGROUND AT LUXOR HOTEL & CASINO

Nostalgia is the name of the game(s) at this over-the-top play space for adults. More than 20 childhood board games get oversized here for maximum fun, alongside two bars for delicious cocktails (and possibly some liquid encouragement). There's no AI or VR here, just pure fun with tactile, puzzle, physical and board games!

SWINGERS LAS VEGAS

This is an adults-only crazy golf and high-end entertainment experience at Mandalay Bay Resort and Casino which contains four crazy golf courses, multiple bars and eateries, the Swingers Carnival arcade concept and more.



THE MOB MUSEUM

This Downtown Las Vegas institution explores the fascinating history of organized crime and law enforcement, featuring four floors of interactive exhibits and artifacts. Don't forget to grab a cocktail at The Underground, a fully functioning distillery and speakeasy housed in the building's basement.

HIGH ROLLER AT THE LINQ PROMENADE

See the Las Vegas Strip and surrounding valley from a unique angle — 360 degrees of them to be exact! With a full rotation taking 30 minutes, the observation wheel brings visitors 550 feet up in the air and provides spectacular views along the way.

VALLEY OF FIRE STATE PARK

Valley of Fire State Park is a must-see while you are visiting Las Vegas. Whether you're coming for the superbloom or craving a scenic drive, Valley of Fire State Park can be reached by using either I-15 or Northshore Drive. Valley of Fire derives its name from the spectacular red sandstone formations formed during the time of the dinosaurs 150 million years ago. This area was home to Ancestral Puebloan farmers. There are many exquisite examples of rock art left by these ancient people, also known as the Anasazi, at several sites within the park. There is also a large variety of desert animals and reptiles located within the park's boundaries. A visitors information center, located within the park, includes exhibits on the geology, prehistory and ecology of the park.

LOST CITY MUSEUM

The Lost City Museum features collections of the early Pueblo Indians in the Southwest. This museum is a journey through the Native American culture of this area, starting 10,000 years ago through about 1000 A.D. The museum also features exhibits relating to Mormon farmers who settled in the valley in 1865.

LAKE MEAD NATIONAL RECREATION AREA

The Northshore Drive of Lake Mead National Recreation Area, Highway 167, can be reached by traveling highways 147 or 166. The view of Lake Mead, created by the completion of Hoover Dam in 1935, is spectacular from Northshore Drive. You may want to stop and have lunch at one of the many marinas or just take in the view from Northshore Drive. This is a great day trip that will take you to Valley of Fire State Park, Lost City Museum, and the rural communities of Logandale and Overton.

RED ROCK CANYON NATIONAL CONSERVATION AREA

Managed by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area is located 20 miles west of Las Vegas and frees you to tap into your wild side. This 197,000-acre area provides a 13-mile scenic drive, more than 30 miles of hiking trails, picnic areas, and a visitors center with exhibit rooms and a bookstore. The Red Rock National Conservation Area offers a unique opportunity to observe some of the best examples of the Mojave Desert. More than 1 million visitors each year enjoy the unique desert landscape, climbing and hiking opportunities, and informative programs offered by the BLM.



SCENIC DRIVE

The 13-mile scenic drive is a one-way road, and bicycles are allowed. Hiking trails, sightseeing and photo opportunities abound in this spectacular setting.

WEDDINGS

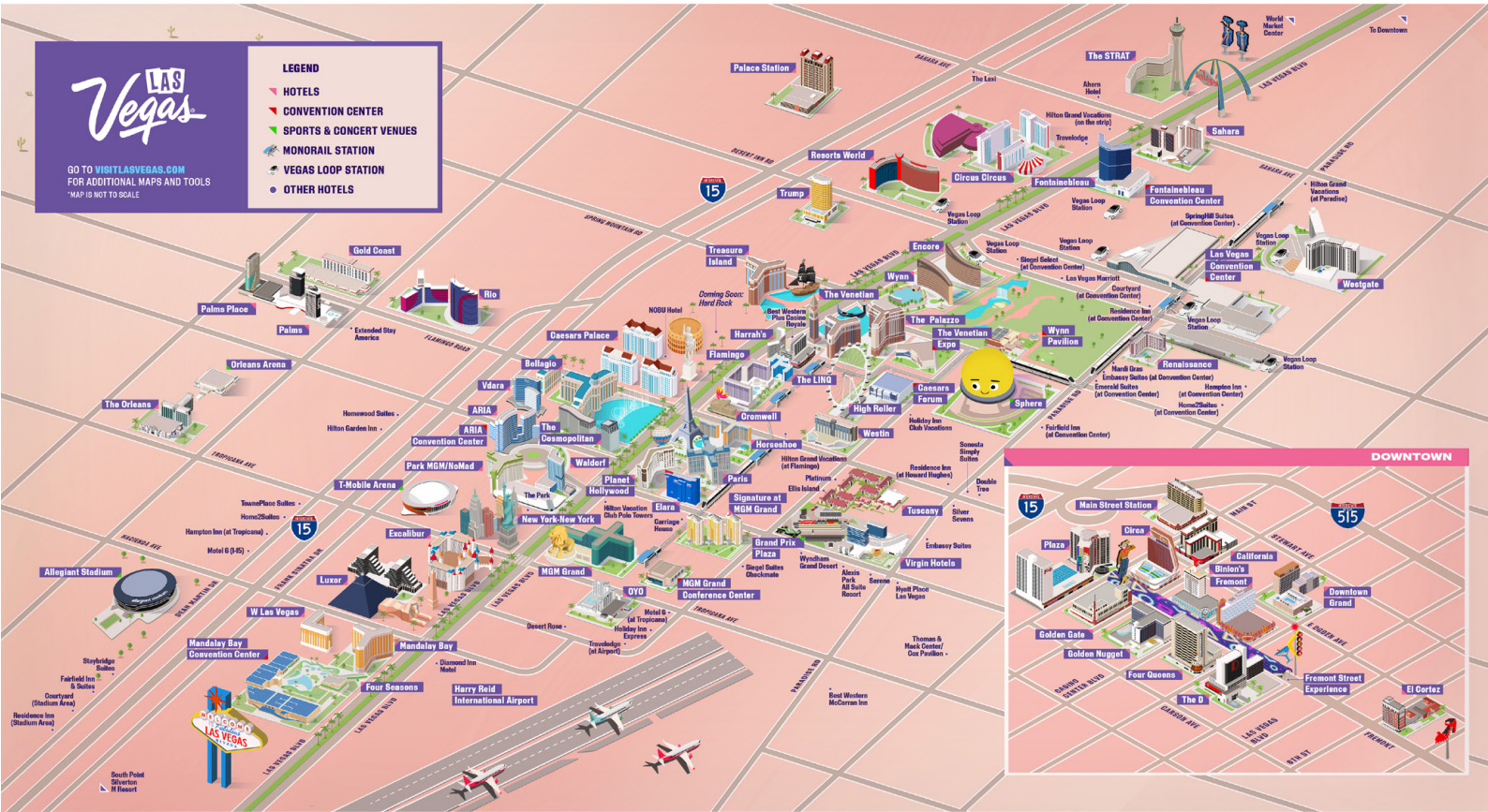
