On June 1, the Elks National Foundation released \$3.7 million for the Spotlight Grants.

Our Lodge will be giving this \$2,000 to the nonprofit "Turning Point" in Bradenton to be used to provide positive and material support to our Manatee County homeless Veterans.

This is just one example of how the Elks National Foundation (ENF) helps our State and local communities. For every dollar we here in Florida donate, we receive back a minimum of \$1.24 to be used for our projects. Not a bad deal!
