



Mayfair Nursery School Illness Policy

This policy has been established to promote a clean, safe and healthy environment for our nursery school students and staff.

Children must be free of fever, vomiting, diarrhea, and off fever and or cold/cough medicines for 24 hours prior to returning to school.

Children who have any illness or condition that can be passed on to others may not return to school until they are no longer contagious. Please notify our school if your child has symptoms of a contagious condition (ex: pink eye, strep throat, chicken pox, head lice, etc.).

If a physician has ordered an antibiotic for your child, he/she must take the medication for 48 hours prior to returning to school.

Children may attend school if they have mild cold symptoms as long as they are not feeling ill, and are able to participate in class activities. **If your child has severe cold symptoms (productive cough, colored drainage from nose, fever) or flu symptoms he/she must stay home.**

Nursery school staff members are not permitted to give children prescription or nonprescription drugs. However, emergency medication such as an epi-pen or inhaler may be dispensed if written consent and instructions are given by the child's parent(s) and physician.

It would be helpful to us if you notify the school by phone before class if your child will be absent for the day. 399-0353
