## Field Trip and End of Year Celebration

### \*Dentist Field Trip- Four Year Old Classes Only

In March our four year old classes will visit Dr.Schummer's dentist office. The office will call me to schedule this field trip. I am assuming that it will be on Monday, 3/25 but that date has not yet been confirmed. I will let you know as soon as I hear from them.

\*The morning class will leave the school at 9:00 am and follow each other to the dentist office, which is located at 170 Saratoga Road in Scotia. We will be in the office for about 1 to 1.5 hours. Parents are welcome to take their children home after the field trip or return them back to school for snack and some class time before the 11:30 pick up.

\*The afternoon class will have their normal 12:15 drop off at school. We will have our snack and some class time before leaving for the dentist office a few minutes after 1:00. The field trip will last about 1 to 1.5 hours. Following the field trip parents are welcome to take their children home right from the office. If I am driving your child, I will have them back for the normal 2:45 pick up time.

\*Please let me know if your child will need a ride to and from the dentist office. I am happy to drive them. Dr.Schummer's office is very small, there will be room for some parents to stay but maybe not all. You may want to plan a Target, grocery store or D&D run during that time. :)

\*A dental hygienist will be visiting school to talk to our 3 year old classes about dental health in March.

### \*VIA Aquarium, Rotterdam or MiSci Museum, Schenectady Three's & Fours

The three year old and four year old classes will visit one of these locations in April. Dates will be set this month and I will let you know as soon as I know more. The 3 PM class will join the 3 AM class on this field trip. Enrichment students will have a regular school day that day.
