Hello Mayfair Families,

May was filled with so much excitement! We started out the month learning about birds and butterflies. We observed our tiny caterpillars grow into large caterpillars then change into chrysalis and finally to butterflies! The children loved learning through first hand observation. They asked great questions. I love their curiosity!

Next, we learned about plants and what they need to live and grown. Each class had an opportunity to plant a different type of seed in our classroom flowerpots. Our Enrichment students planted sunflowers and got to take them home. Finally, the children loved helping Ms. Stephanie and Ms. Holly plant the flowers in our flower boxes behind the school. They look beautiful! Thank you to Emmitt and his mom, Jen, for donating them!

Later in the month, we learned about the farm and chicks/chickens. We learned about chicks and waited a very patient 23 days for our chicks to hatch. (They are supposed to take 21 days but we are learning that ours usually hatch around the 23<sup>rd</sup> day!) Each day we learned about how our chicks were growing inside of their eggs. Then, some of us actually got to watch a chick hatch from their egg! We were so thankful that 10 of our eggs hatched! We had a chance to watch them, pet them and hold them! They are now at the fish family's house getting big so fast!

Toward the end of the month we learned about Fairy Tales. I loved seeing how mesmerized the children became by each of the stories! Their favorites were Jack and the Beanstalk, Goldilocks and the Three Bears and The Three Billy Goats Gruff.

We will finish out the end of the school year learning about the zoo, preparing for Father's Day and our for our End of the Year Celebrations. We will take the time to really enjoy our final days of the school year together!

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Usually during the summer I offer "Summer Fun Days" at Mayfair. 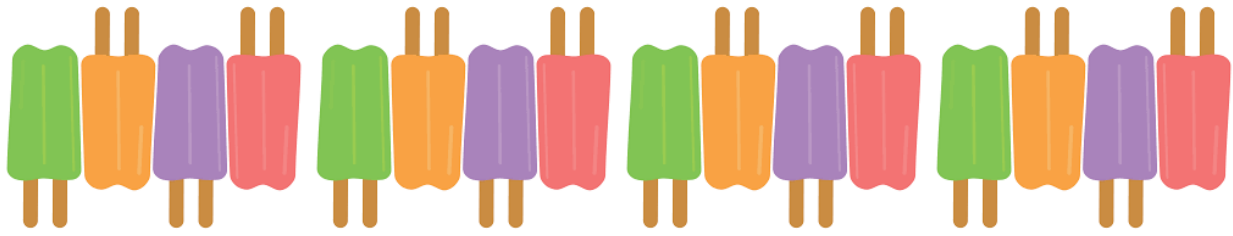

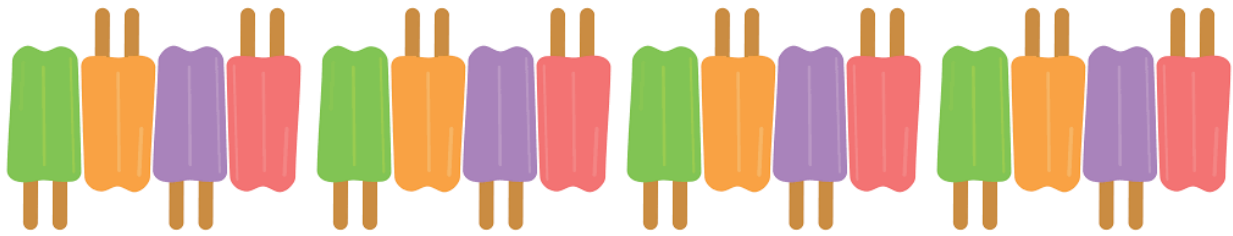
