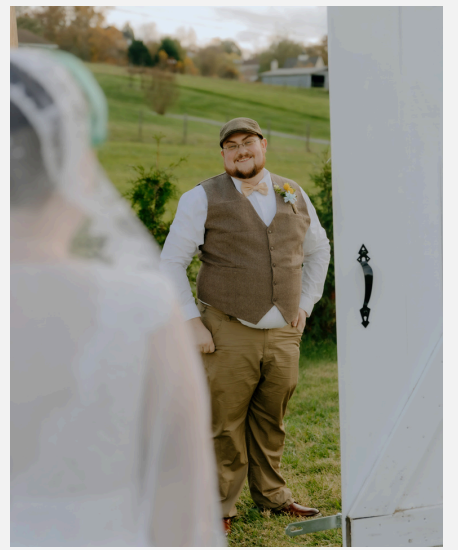

Getting Ready Shots

The getting ready photos capture the intimate moments before the ceremony. For the bride, you'll see her mom zipping up her dress, bridesmaids adjusting her hair, and her putting in her earrings. On the groom's side, expect shots of him adjusting his bowtie, while his groomsmen help with the final details. These moments highlight the love and support surrounding the couple as they prepare for their big day.





How much TIME DO WE *Need?*

When deciding how much time to book a wedding photographer for, it really depends on how much of the day you want captured. If you're looking for full coverage—including getting ready pictures, a first look, ceremony, portraits, and the entire reception—8 to 10 hours is usually the best choice. This allows your photographer to capture all the key moments without feeling rushed.

However, if you're planning a more intimate or simple wedding and only want coverage of the ceremony with a few photos afterward, a 4-hour package could be a good fit. That being said, it's always a good idea to book a little extra time if possible, just in case things run late or you want to make sure you don't miss any special moments. Having that buffer can help ensure everything is documented without any stress.

Couples



PORTRAITS

Couples portraits are some of the most important photos of your wedding day because they capture the raw, intimate emotions shared between you and your partner. These images not only preserve the essence of your love but also serve as timeless reminders of the joy and connection you felt in that moment. Taking the time for portraits ensures you'll have beautiful, personal photos that you'll cherish for a lifetime, reflecting the true spirit of your special day.



Family Portraits **TIPS + TRICKS**

Shot List

Please create a shot list that includes all the different groupings you would like photographed, along with the names of the family members.

Crowd Control

If you do not have a day of coordinator, I recommend putting someone from your bridal party in charge of crowd control during family portraits. It's sometimes hard to keep everyone focused with so much going on!

Keep it quick

We can knock out family portraits fairly quickly. We always get a ton of pictures of the immediate family. I recommend trying to do bigger group shots for the more distant relatives (IE: Aunts, Cousins, etc.)

Inform Family

Make it clear that your family should gather after the ceremony for family pictures, or instruct your officiant to announce it!

Keep In Mind



Lighting

Lighting is crucial for setting the mood! Different types of lighting can create various atmospheres. For a warmer, softer vibe, consider using string lights, candles, and lanterns. In contrast, white lights and large windows can provide a brighter, cleaner ambiance. While some venues may offer colorful lights, I recommend avoiding them if you can!



Reception Location

Your reception location is just as important as your ceremony location! Be sure to pick somewhere that feels like you. Lighting is important, be sure to add ambient light to set the mood, Opt out of colorful DJ lights as they tend to mess up the skin tones in pictures.



Send Off

Send-offs are always a lot of fun! I recommend planning a fake send-off before the reception ends, especially if you want your guests to be involved. Get creative with your send-off options; vintage cars, sparklers, bubbles, and flower petals all make for exciting ideas and great photos!



Speeches

The number one tip for speeches is to keep them short and sweet. While it's easy to talk about someone you love for 10 minutes, I recommend that speakers limit their speeches to 3-5 minutes. It's also a good idea to have the speaker stand near the sweetheart table, so I can capture reactions!

Editing Process

Recieve Unedited

Within 7 days of your wedding day you will receive a link including all of the unedited images shot during your wedding.

Select Favorites

You will be able to create a favorites list of the images you'd like edited that are included in your package

Recieve Finals

4-6 Weeks after you have selected your favorites, you will receive your final gallery.



Frequently ASKED Questions

Do you offer prints/do we get prints with our package?

I do not offer prints at this time. My packages include digital images you can get printed wherever you choose.

Do you pose us?

Yes! I will pose you, as well as give you prompts to capture the most natural images!

When is the payment due after I paid my deposit?

The remaining balance isn't due until the wedding day!

How much are extra edited images?

Extra edited images are \$5 each, but the price goes down the more you purchase!

Technology sometimes malfunctions, what precautions do you take?

My camera has dual card slots, meaning I always have a backup card in case the first one malfunctions for some reason. After the wedding, the images are backed up on an external hard drive as well as on Pixieset immediately.

Do you do the traditional posed family portraits?

Normally right after the ceremony, we do traditional posed family portraits. This is optional, but most couples do choose to have this done!

Do you carry backup equipment?

I always have my backup camera, several lenses, batteries & SD cards readily available.



Frequently ASKED Questions

What happens if you get sick/ have an emergency on the wedding day?

Although this has never happened before, If I am unable to shoot your wedding due to an emergency I've got you covered. I will have an associate shooter at your wedding and ensure they have a similar style & approach. You'll be in good hands no matter what!

Do you travel for weddings?

Absolutely! I love a good destination wedding. Pricing varies depending on destinations.

When is the payment due after I paid my deposit?

The remaining balance isn't due until the wedding day!

What if our wedding gets postponed?

No worries! Life happens. If you need to reschedule, just let me know as soon as possible. I'll do my best to accommodate your new date.

What happens if it rains on our wedding day?

Rain on your wedding day is good luck after all! If it rains, no worries. It adds to the romance and we will be sure to get beautiful pictures regardless.

Can we give you a shot list?

I love capturing the uniqueness of every wedding. Although I'll have plenty of ideas, if you have any must-have shots feel free to share them with me!
