Yellow and Red Cards Fines

The document below details how the club will deal with fines received as a result of a player receiving a yellow or red card during one of its matches. Any fines will need to be paid for by the player or his parent / guardian. The process is:

- Team manager to inform Club Sec on the day of the match with details of any bookings, including player name and reason for the caution.
- Team manager to inform parent of caution and that fine is due for payment by Thursday night and they will be informed of this by the Club Sec
- Ref will submit report and the Club Sec will then be notified via the FA's Whole Game system of any caution, the reasons for it, the fine, and in the case if a red card the length of any ban
- Club will pay fine to FA on behalf of the player
- Club Sec will then contact players parents via e mail confirming the caution with an invoice for the amount of the fine, and if a red card details of the suspension. This invoice needs to be paid by the Thursday following the match in which the caution was received.
- On Friday the Club Sec will contact the manager and player to confirm if payment has been made. If no payment has been made, then the player will be ineligible for selection for the weekends game.

Fines for cards are:

- Yellow Card £12
- Red Card £40
