Two Ways To Purchase

Custom Processing:

Purchase the animal in person or online and choose a cut-and-wrap facility from our approved list. Processing is not included in the animal's purchase price.

Turn:

Support an exhibitor without keeping the meat. After purchase, indicate TURN and our buyers will take the animal at floor price—you pay only the difference (e.g., buy at \$2.00/lb, floor price \$1.00/lb, you pay \$1.00/lb).

Terms of the Sale:

Payment is encouraged on the day of the sale. The office will be open for 30 minutes following the completion of the show

WHY SHOULD I PURCHASE MEAT FROM THE NWJLS?

Students from across Washington State dedicate countless hours to raising homegrown, high-quality market animals for the NWJLS auction. Exhibitors must complete a quality assurance form to ensure every animal was properly fed and cared for—so you can feel confident bringing safe, locally raised meat to your table.

WHAT DO I GET FROM MY PURCHASE?

Below is an approximate breakdown of the average sized animal

1200 pound steer

720 pounds of carcass weight
485 pounds of wrapped meat

240 pound hog

144 pounds of carcass weight
115 pounds of wrapped meat

120 pound lamb or goat

60 pounds of carcass weight
40 pounds of wrapped meat
