



This is a picture taken during the tribal festival 'Gavri' in Rajasthan during the monsoon season. In Gavri all the female characters are played by the male artists, it is a 40-day long festival. These are not all-time artists. Gavri festival is celebrated with a very minimalistic approach. Artist doesn't spend much on the make and clothing. They usually use the donated clothes and material during their performance. All the artists remain barefoot during the entire 40 days. They sleep on the ground and do not eat non veg and drink alcohol during this period. More importantly this is not their full-time livelihood. Most of the artists migrate and work as labourers in the nearby state to earn money.




