

"Information and Assistance" service is offered by COEDD Area Agency on Aging (AAA) to provide information on services in our 7-county Planning & Service Area for older Oklahomans and their families. This is the first step toward self advocacy by linking senior citizens with the resources and services in their communities, to enable them to maintain as independent a lifestyle as possible. The AAA Long Term Care Ombudsmen visit residents at nursing homes, assisted living facilities, and residential care homes to monitor the care and quality of life residents receive there and help resolve complaints.

The COEDD AAA receives funds annually from the Special Unit on Aging, Department of Human Services through a matching fund agreement with the Central Oklahoma Economic Development District (COEDD). Services currently funded through COEDD-AAA are <u>Nutrition</u> through Project H.E.A.R.T., Inc. and New Age Project, Inc.; <u>Senior Law Project</u> through Legal Aid of Oklahoma; and <u>Caregiver Services</u> and <u>Outreach Services</u> through the AAA. These services are available without charge for all citizens age 60+ regardless of race, color, sex, handicap or national origin. Funded projects accept donations, in the attempt to serve as many as possible.

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OKLAHOMA LIVING CHOICE PROGRAM

What is The Oklahoma Living Choice Program?

This program assists Oklahomans who want to transition out of a nursing home and back into a residence of their own. This program has helped transition more than 800 residents back into their communities and has saved the state nearly \$8.5 million in rebalancing funds.

Services Offered

Depending on an individual's needs. services may include:

- Assistance with finding a new residence.
- Home-delivered meals.
- Transportation.
- Skilled nursing.
- Therapy services.
- Personal care.
- Medication management.
- Transitional funds (one-time allotment of up to \$2,400).

Eligibility

To qualify, individuals must meet the following requirements:

- Be at least 19 years of age.
- · Qualify for SoonerCare (Oklahoma's Medicaid program) for at least one day prior to transition.
- · Have lived in an institutional setting (nursing home) for at least 60 consecutive days.
- Voluntarily want to transition back into the community.
- Be willing to play an active role in their plan of care.
