3. Introduction of Guests – No guests
4. Mobility Managers Report:
  - a. **Outreach/Engagement:** I continue to participate in numerous community and coalition meetings each month to raise awareness of Mobility Management and strengthen local partnerships. In February, I participated in 16 unique community engagements where Mobility Management resources and coordination opportunities were discussed.

Additional outreach activities included attending the Oklahoma Emergency Management Association Conference as a vendor, where I established valuable connections to support coordination with emergency management partners and enhance transportation considerations within emergency operations. I also attended the OARC Legislative Breakfast, which provided an opportunity to connect with local lawmakers and stakeholders and share the ongoing work and impact of mobility management efforts.

Further engagement included participation in the Developmental Disabilities Day Committee planning meetings and Sibshops advisory board meetings. These efforts



support continued collaboration with disability advocacy partners and help expand awareness of transportation resources available to individuals and families.

- b. **Coordination/Communication:** A lack of shared understanding around what effective coordination looks like continues to present a barrier to meaningful progress. Many agencies view participation in meetings and discussions as the primary form of coordination. While these conversations are valuable, they do not always translate into collaborative actions or shared service strategies.

Developing and implementing tangible coordination projects will be critical in moving beyond discussion toward measurable outcomes. Initiatives such as Conifer Transit have the potential to provide practical examples of coordinated service delivery and demonstrate the benefits of partnership across agencies.

Projects like this can help establish clearer models of what coordination looks like in practice and support the broader goal of building a more integrated and efficient transportation network across Oklahoma.
