His projects include the spoken poem audiobook Triple Threat Love Letter, a poignant and honest exploration of love, loss, and the intricate tapestry of human connection. After losing his mother, Major Katrina Mathews, to pancreatic cancer, he created the audio zine project Death Before Achievement. This multimedia collection of non-fiction spoken word and visual accompaniments explores themes of death, struggle, addiction, and mental health.

Mark's latest work, the highly anticipated non-fiction memoir Christmas in July: The White Lie, audiobook is an unfiltered journey through profound deceptions, systemic illusions, and the relentless pursuit of truth. Set to be released by FLUSH Publishing, this audiobook delves into challenging themes of racial identity, betrayal, and systemic injustice, calling on listeners to confront uncomfortable truths and question prevailing narratives.

As a dedicated literary entrepreneur, Mark is a testament to the power of self-publishing and artistic independence. His collaboration with Semicolon Independent Bookstore, where FLUSH Publishing was an exclusive vendor for their block party, underscores a shared belief that "reading is a form of resistance against ignorance." He is currently on a book tour, connecting with audiences and sharing his message of empowerment and healing, with an upcoming performance at Da Book Joint in Chicago. Mark L.
