DAY 1: ARRIVAL – PHNOM PENH – SIHANOUKVILLE [BY ROAD]

Arrival at Phnom Penh Airport, you will be meeting our driver and transfer direct to SIHANOUKVILLE. It's take 4 hours drive on good condition road. Arrive and check in hotel, free your own leisure at walking street along sand beach.

DAY 4: SIHANOUK VILLE - PHNOM PENH – CITY TOUR [B]

Breakfast at hotel, check out and we transfer back to Phnom Penh city, arrive and check in hotel.

today discover the Phnom Penh City, visit WAT PHNOM PAGODA, an ancient pagoda stands up on the hill, Independence Monument commemorates the end of Cambodia's ruled by France in 1953. Then visit to CENTRAL MARKET [Phsar Thmei], this distinctive building is a city landmark & the busiest market in the city with a unique art deco version of a traditional market and the market constructed in 1935-37, during the French colonial period, Phsar Thmey is currently just completed its renovation and become the central section of the main market building displays an amazing collection of gems, jewelry and souvenirs.

DAY 5: PHNOM PENH – CRUISE TOUR [B]

Breakfast at hotel, continue to infamous TUOL SLENG and CHEUNG EK, better known as the Killing Fields, where large numbers of people were killed and buried in mass graves.

Afternoon visit the NATIONAL MUSEUM built in 1917-18 is exclusively dedicated to Khmer arts. And then visit ROYAL PALACE built in 1866 and SILVER PAGODA located within the Royal Palace compound.

Evening enjoy cruise tour at MEKONG RIVER.

DAY 6: PHNOM PENH – SIEM REAP [B]

Breakfast at hotel, Breakfast at your hotel, we're transfer to Bus station and get vehicle to SIEM REAP take around 6hours. On arrival your will be met and then transfer direct to your select hotel for refreshment.

Afternoon CHONG KNEAS one of natural tourisms and a mangrove for hundreds of species of fresh water fishes and birds and decorated with ethnic stilted houses line over the water surface up to the air. The villages are primarily Khmer and have about 3000 inhabitants between them, most of who live in stilted houses. The people depend largely on fishing and tourism for their incomes. We embark on the traditional wooden boat through the flooded forests of the GREAT TONLE SAP LAKE, habitat of many bird species it will bring you to Chong Kneas. This amazing floating village is built on 8 to 10 m high stilts. We visit an island pagoda, a school and traditional stilt houses to interact with the local families. Return to Siem Reap for refreshment.

DAY 7: SIEM REAP – TEMPLE TOUR [B]

Breakfast at hotel, continue tour to ANGKOR THOM covers an area of 10 square km. Enclosed by a wall and wide moats; the city includes many of Angkor's most popular sights. Enter by the monumental SOUTH GATE over a causeway lined on either side by statues of demons and gods, each carrying a giant naga. Continue to the TERRACE OF THE ELEPHANTS and the TERRACE OF THE LEPER KINGS, former spaces for public ceremonies, both adorned with dramatic bas reliefs. Visit the ruined BAPHUON, ROYAL ENCLOSURE and PHIMEANAKAS before continuing to the mysterious BAYON TEMPLE. In this temple, one of the most popular and compelling in Angkor, explore the galleries of beautifully preserved bas reliefs and ascend narrow stairs to reach the central sanctuary, where you will find giant stone faces smiling enigmatically down at you from every angle.

Afternoon crowning jewel of Khmer architecture, ANGKOR WAT TEMPLE is the national symbol and the highlight of any visit to Cambodia. The largest, best preserved, and most religiously significant of the Angkor temples, Angkor impresses visitors both by its sheer scale and beautifully proportioned layout, as well as the delicate artistry of its carvings. To approach the temple, first cross the vast moat,

Continuing along a broad causeway lined with naga balustrades. As you enter the main building, ascend through a series of galleries and courtyard before reaching the central sanctuary, which offers beautiful views back over the causeway and across the surrounding countryside. Visit TA PROHM TEMPLE, one of the most popular attractions of Angkor as much of the jungle has not been cleared and it looks very much as most of the Angkor monuments would have appeared when European explorers first stumbled across them.

DAY 8: SIEM REAP – KULEN MOUNTAIN [B]

Breakfast at hotel, we transfer to visit the Thousand Lingas under the spring water situated Kulen Mountain also locals called Mahindra Barwada, also can see Sleeping Buddha under the spring and natural water spring and water fall. We will enjoy take-away lunch box by the river. After the tour transfer back to the city.

Afternoon explore city tour to visit ANGKOR SILK FARM offers free guided tours of the process from the mulberry bushes cultivation to the production of silk fabrics and accessories. As the Silk Farm covers an area of 8 hectares, of which 5 are used for the mulberry trees plantation, you will enjoy the beautiful setting while learning about the fascinating process of silk-making. WEST BARAY is the largest man-made body of water at Angkor. Visitors can hire a boat to take them to the island in the middle



where West Mebon temple once stood. Today, only traces of it remain. But the island is a pleasant spot for a picnic or just walking around when water level is low. Alternatively, visitor can also go for a refreshing swim.
