

<u>Acknowledgement of Parent Participation Policies</u>

Parent's play a critical role in their children's development. We ask all families enrolled in Mid-Mitten Montessori to participate in the following ways during the year:

- Snack Week: Each child will be expected to bring in items for snack during an assigned week. Kindergarten and first grade students may be asked to provide items twice during the school year. The snack calendar will be in the vestibule. If you do not sign up for a week to bring in snack, a teacher will sign you up for the week. Snack baskets come home on Thursday or Friday for the following week.
- Flower Arranging: Sporadically throughout the year we will ask for volunteers to bring in a bouquet of fresh flowers. The students will arrange fresh flowers in the classroom, and help with making our classroom beautiful. These can be donated at any time, or if we need them for a specific time, we will post it on the Volunteer Board in the vestibule.

For each of the above items, on your assigned week, items will need to be dropped off with your child on Monday morning (or the first day of the week if Monday is a school holiday). You will receive a reminder and list of requested items shortly before your assigned week. If you need to change your assigned week, please feel free to reach out to other parents to change weeks with them and notify Ms. Kerri once arrangements are finalized so our schedule can be updated. If your child is absent from school on the day you are scheduled to drop off items, please make arrangements for someone to drop the items off at school or to change weeks. When possible, please have your child participate in selecting items to bring to the classroom. You will receive a schedule of assigned weeks during the first week of school.
