
READATHON RULES

- The official start to the Read-a-Thon is Friday, October 11, 2019.
- The official end of the Read-a-Thon is Friday, October 25, 2019.
- Record the number of minutes you read each day on your Daily Reading Log.
 - Reading before and after school counts.
 - Being read to by other people counts.
 - Reading aloud to other people counts. If you read to someone who is also participating in the Read-a-Thon, it counts for both of you!
 - Reading under the bed covers, with a flashlight, late at night counts (but only if it's ok with your parents!).
 - Assigned reading homework counts (including book report reading).
 - Reading magazines and newspapers counts.
 - Practicing sight words counts for Kindergarten and First Graders.
 - Reading before the official beginning of the Read-a-Thon does not count.
 - Reading instead of doing other homework does not count.
 - Reading during class time does not count except for teacher-designated class time.

Do not guess or round off minutes. Please look at a clock or use a time/stopwatch to monitor your minutes. Remember that CHARACTER COUNTS – be honest with your minutes so that this will be fair and fun for everyone. A parent or other adult must initial the minutes read on your Daily Reading Log.
