INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS ON ERIN MILLS PARKWAY (EMP) CITY OF MISSISSAUGA, PROJECT 19-4230

Where is the work happening?

- Intersection of EMP and Dundas Street West
- Intersection of EMP and Sheridan Park Drive/Lincoln Green Way
- Intersection of EMP and Fowler Drive/Leanne Boulevard

What are we doing?

- The work includes:
 - o Sidewalk, bus stop and grading restorations at EMP and Dundas;
 - o Pavement and line marking restorations at EMP and Sheridan Park Drive
 - Installation of Oil Grit Separation (OGS) north of EMP and Lincoln Green Way to improve wastewater and stormwater discharge leading into Lake Ontario:
 - Intersection improvements and traffic signal modifications at EMP and Fowler Drive/Leanne Boulevard;
 - addition of a right turn lane on Fowler Drive
 - removal and replacement of sidewalk, curbs and gutters;
 - installation of new bus bay, cross rides and cycle tracks;
 - asphalt milling and hot mix paving;
 - pavement markings and restorations

When?

• Construction Start: July 2022 - Finish: November 2022 (weather permitting)

Working Hours

- Hours of operation are from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday and work may also be done on Saturdays.
- These hours follow the city's by-laws. Extended working hours may cause some inconvenience to the public, however will help facilitate completion of the project as quickly as possible.
- The work will be completed by **Pave Al Limited** on the Region's behalf.

Traffic Control

- The project will be phased to minimize traffic disruption while maintaining a safe working environment as required under the Occupational Health and Safety Act.
- Existing traffic flows will be maintained during construction. However, due to the nature of the work, we will need to reduce traffic lanes to a single lane (each direction) and temporarily block intersection during construction.
- Emergency access will be maintained at all times.
- Please use caution when travelling through the work zone.

Driveway Access

 We will maintain driveway access as much as possible. Should we need to block your driveway for a short time, you will be contacted to arrange for the best time • We will make sure businesses have access at all times.
