

Bridge Rehabilitation on Burnhamthorpe Road West Over the Credit River - Stage Two Construction -

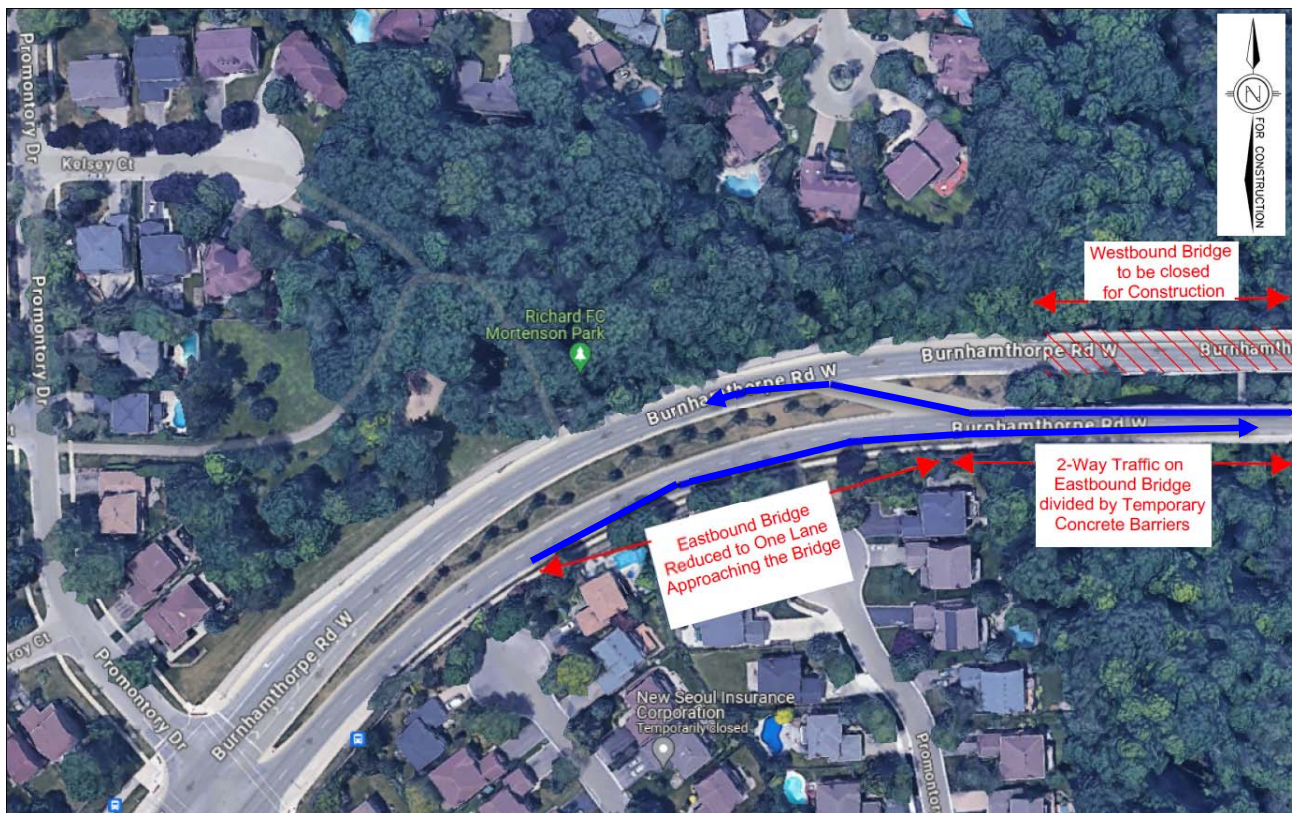
Stage Two Construction Duration: **April 29 to July 31, 2024**
Entire Construction Duration: October 16, 2023 to November 30, 2024

Project Overview

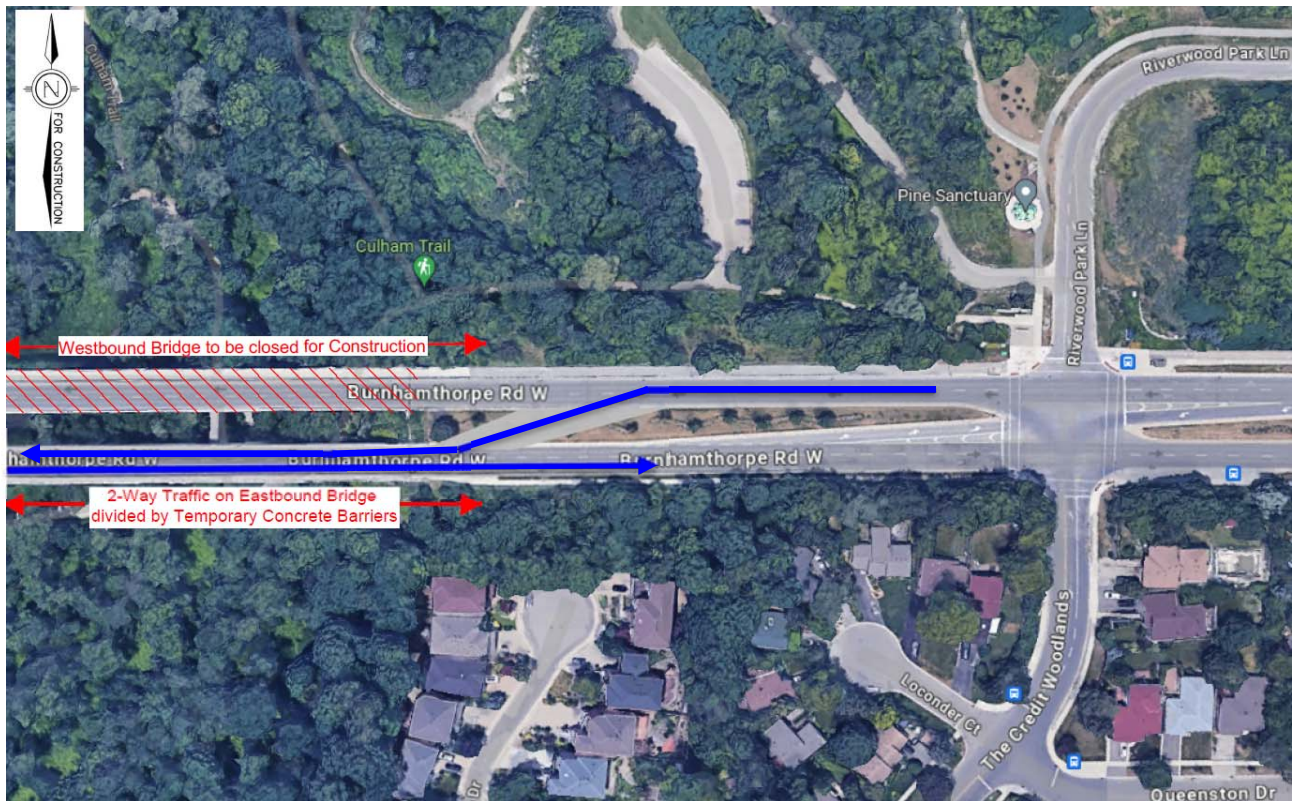
The bridge retrofit work on Burnhamthorpe Road West over the Credit River will be moving to Stage 2 construction. The new construction staging will begin on **Monday, April 29**, after the Mississauga Marathon. The new traffic pattern will involve the following:

- Closing the north bridge and the north sidewalk
- Both eastbound lane and westbound lane will be reduced from two (2) lanes to one (1) lane. Please follow the traffic control signage and reduce the driving speed while traveling.

Work Details

The scope of the bridge rehabilitation in Stage Two construction will include the following:

- Remove and repair deteriorated concrete various locations on the north bridge. This includes bridge deck, sidewalk, girders, and pier caps.
- Re-construct new ballast walls and sewer catch basins.
- Replace deck drains.
- Replace expansion joints and approach slabs.
- Replace bridge bearings.
- Replace asphalt surface and waterproofing.

The last construction staging is anticipated to start in August. The City will provide a construction update with more details prior to the commencement of the final staging.



What to Expect During Stage Two Construction

Impacts	There will be some construction related dust, noise and traffic delays. The City will make every effort to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience and cooperation. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained.	
Work Hours	Work will occur between 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday. Work after hours and on weekends will be limited to an as-needed basis.	
Vehicle, Pedestrians and Cyclists Access	Roads	The two westbound lanes on the north bridge will be closed. One westbound and eastbound lane will be maintained via a crossover traffic detour. Road users should expect delays. Please follow traffic control signage posted on site.
	Sidewalks	The north sidewalk and multi-use trail will be closed . Please use the south sidewalk instead. Cyclists will need to dismount while using the south sidewalk.
	Trail	The Culham Trail underneath the bridge between the Lower Parking Lot and the first bridge pier will be re-opened after April 26, 2024 .
Transit Service	There is no change to MiWay transit services for Route #26. Please visit the MiWay website for updates: https://www.mississauga.ca/miway-transit/announcements/	
Parking	The lower parking lot at The Riverwood Park will be re-opened after April 26, 2024 .	
Restoration	The construction site will be restored with sod, trees, and replanting of flower beds after bridge work has been completed.	
Utility Disruptions	Temporary disruptions to utilities (i.e. gas, hydro, water, telecommunications and cable TV) may be experienced. Every effort will be made to promptly restore service.
