

Bridge Rehabilitation on Burnhamthorpe Road West Over the Credit River



Stage Three Construction Duration: **August 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024**Entire Construction Duration: October 16, 2023 to December 31, 2024

Thank you for your patience while the City continues to retrofit the twin bridges on Burnhamthorpe Road West over the Credit River. The City's Contractor will complete the retrofitting of the north bridge soon and will be moving to Stage 3 of construction. The new construction staging will begin on or after **August 1, 2024.** The new traffic pattern will involve the following:


- Re-opening the north bridge and north sidewalk / multi-use trail.
- Closing the south bridge and the south sidewalk.
- Maintain one (1) eastbound lane and one (1) westbound lane on the north bridge. Please follow the traffic control signage and reduce driving speed.

Work Details

The scope of the bridge rehabilitation in Stage Three construction will include the following:

- Repair deteriorated concrete at various locations on the south bridge. This includes bridge deck, sidewalk, girders, and pier caps.
- Re-construct new ballast walls and sewer catch basins.
- Replace deck drains.
- Replace expansion joints.
- Replace approach slabs.
- Replace bridge bearings.
- Replace asphalt surface and waterproofing.



What to Expect During **Stage Three** Construction

Impacts	There will be some construction related dust, noise and traffic delays. The City will make every effort to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience and cooperation. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained.		
Work Hours	Work will occur between 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday. Work after hours and on weekends will be limited to an as-needed basis.		
Vehicle, Pedestrians and Cyclists Access	Roads	The vehicle lanes on the south bridge will be closed. One (1) westbound and one (1) eastbound lane will be maintained on the north bridge via a crossover traffic detour. Road users should expect delays. Please follow traffic control signage posted on site.	
	Sidewalks	The south sidewalk will be closed. Please use the north sidewalk and multi-use trail instead.	
	Trail	The Culham Trail underneath the bridge between the Lower Parking Lot and the first bridge pier has been re-opened.	
Transit Service	There is no change to MiWay transit services for Route #26. Please visit the MiWay website for updates: https://www.mississauga.ca/miway-transit/announcements/		
Parking	The lower parking lot at The Riverwood Park has been re-opened.		
Restoration	The construction site will be restored with sod, trees, and replanting of flower beds after bridge work has been completed.		
Utility Disruptions	Temporary disruptions to utilities (i.e. gas, hydro, water, telecommunications and cable TV) may be experienced. Every effort will be made to promptly restore service.
