REHABILITATION OF THE COLLEGEWAY FROM WINSTON CHURCHILL BOULEVARD TO MISSISSAUGA ROAD

Construction scheduled to commence: on or after July 24, 2023


Construction scheduled to be completed: on or before November 30, 2024

Project Overview

The City will be rehabilitating The Collegeway from Winston Churchill Boulevard to Mississauga Road.

This project is part of the City's Integrated Road Program, an initiative that aims to streamline the design and construction of infrastructure projects and improve collaboration during project delivery through the bundling of various road improvement projects. A map illustrating the project area is shown below.

The proposed work includes pavement rehabilitation, intersection improvements, new traffic signals and street lights, curb, sidewalk and catch basin repairs and maintenance, and installation of cycle tracks (Winston Churchill Boulevard to South Millway).



What to Expect During Construction

Impact/ Safety	Dust, noise and other inconveniences may be experienced. The City will make every effort to reduce these impacts. Avoid contact with hot asphalt or any construction material at all times.				
Work Hours	Work will occur between 7:00am and 7:00pm, Monday to Friday.				
Sprinkler Systems	During curb and sidewalk removal, sprinkler systems could become damaged. It is the property owner's responsibility to remove fixtures such as sprinkler heads and sprinkler systems encroaching on City property prior to construction. The City will not be responsible for any damages to these fixtures.				
Driveways Access	Access to driveways may be interrupted for short periods due to construction. If the curb in front of the property is being replaced, the construction crew will remove half of the driveway at a time to allow for access at all times. If you have more than one driveway, at least one driveway will remain open at all times. Driveway access to single detached homes: During road resurfacing, driveway access will be interrupted for approximately two-three days. Arrangements will be made for parking exemptions on surrounding streets.				
Parking	On-street parking on The Collegeway is prohibited. Residents can park on side streets if their driveway is not accessible due to construction. Parking enforcement officers will not issue tickets for "Parking in Excess of Five				

		while your driveway is not accessible. Parking tickets will still be issued for violations such as parking he traffic flow, parking too close to a corner, fire hydrant or other parking restricted areas.
