## CONSTRUCTION OF LOW IMPACT DEVELOPMENT (LID) ON ERIN MILLS PARKWAY SOUTH OF HIGHWAY 403, CITY OF MISSISSAUGA, PROJECT 22-3040

### What are we doing?

- This project involves a Low Impact Development (LID) retrofit for a Stormwater Management Facility in Peel Region, aimed at reducing runoff and improving stormwater quality.
- Removing and replacing curbs, gutters, sidewalks, and other related infrastructure.
- Restoration work and minor associated tasks.

### Where?

- On Erin Mills Parkway South of Highway 403 and approximately 250 meters north of Burnhamthorpe Road, City of Mississauga

### When?

- Start: week of October 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024
- Finish: November 30, 2024, weather permitting.
