Plein Air Competition: JUNE 3, 4, & 5, 2022



Artists check in either Friday, **June 3, 9:00 am to 4:00 pm** or **Saturday, June 4, from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm** or **before 12:00 Sunday, June 5, at the Bandstand, Carnegie Park, Corner of 4th and K Streets**, Livermore. Bring up to 4 painting surfaces which will be stamped on the back. A map & list of suggested sites will be sent via email after your application is received. Deadline: May 27. Open competition. Artwork done only from June 3 to June 5 within the Livermore area and stamped by LAA are eligible to be judged. Two (2) may be presented for final competition on Sunday, June 5 from 2:00 to 3:00 pm in Carnegie Park near the Bandstand. Artists must bring their own easel for display, judging & sales. Remember to bring business cards. Don't forget that you will be pricing your work when it is finished. **Watercolors must be matted before judging.** Framing not required. No size limitations. Judging starts at 3:00 pm, Sunday, June 5. No artwork may be removed before 4:00 pm.

The park can get windy so be prepared to tie down your gear.
