Entry Fee & Registration

- Eligibility: Open to all
- **Fee:** \$15 per piece, up to five pieces (no refunds). Acceptance is on a first-come, first-served basis.
- **Registration:** Registration is online only at www.livermoreartassociation.org.
- **Payment:** online or by check payable to the Livermore Art Association or LAA. You may bring a check to receiving.
- **Sponsorships available:** If you would like to enter but cannot afford the fees, you may apply for a sponsorship by contacting show chair Heather Dever at heather.dever@livermoreart.org and explaining your situation. Explanations will be kept in confidence.

Entry Requirements

Artwork Size

 Only 2D work is accepted for this show. Work may include some 3D elements, but needs to be hangable.

• Minimum Size: 11 x 14 inches

• Maximum Size: 48 inches high, 40 inches wide

Original Work

- **Original art, photographs, or Al.** Art, photographs, or Al-assisted work must be original and solely created by the submitting artist.
- No classwork, supervised pieces, or copies of other art are allowed.
- Al-assisted art is acceptable only if the human artist had significant input. All must be listed as a medium.





Family-Friendly Policy

- Artwork must align with the Library's family-friendly standards.
- The Show Chair has sole discretion to accept or reject submissions.

Preparing for Hanging

- Hanging Requirements:
 - Artwork must be wired and properly framed or have finished edges with flat mountings (D-ring and wire).
 - Prohibited Hanging Methods: Screw eyes, sawtooth hangers, poster frames, or Lucite clip frames. They will NOT be accepted.
- Labeling:
 - Label the back of the artwork with your name, phone number, and title of the piece. Optional: Add one to two sentences describing the your piece.

Insurance

Artists are responsible for insuring their work.

LAA, City of Livermore, or Livermore Library are **not liable** for loss or damage during handling or exhibition.

Sales

- A 20% commission on all sales will go to LAA.
- **Display Duration:** Artwork must remain on display for the entire show.
 - If sold, the artwork will be given to the buyer on March 31, unless other arrangements are made.
 - o If the artwork is given to the buyer early, it must be replaced with another piece.
