Fees & Registration

Eligibility: Open to LAA members only

Fees:

- \$15 per piece, up to five pieces per artist
- Maximum of 60 artworks. Acceptance is on a first-come, first-served basis.
- No refunds.

Registration:

- Registration is online only at www.livermoreartassociation.org.
- Notes on the registration form fields:
 - *Artwork size* should be the size of the actual piece without frame.
 - *About the Piece* is intended for an artist's statement about their inspiration or meaning. This is optional.

Payment: online or by check payable to the Livermore Art Association or LAA. You may bring a check to receiving.



LAA's *Support an Artist* funds are available to anyone who cannot afford the entry fee. Email the show chair for details before registering.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Artwork Size

Only 2D work is accepted for this show. Work may include 3D elements provided it is hangable.

Minimum Size: 11 x 14 inches finished dimensions

Maximum Size: 48 inches high, 40 inches wide finished dimensions

Original Work

Original art, photographs, or AI. Art, photographs, or AI-assisted work must be original and solely created by the submitting artist.

No classwork, supervised pieces, or copies of other art are allowed.

AI-assisted art is acceptable **only if** the human artist had significant input. AI must be listed as a medium.

Library and LAA Policy

Artwork must align with the Library's family-friendly standards.

Please note that **Library policy prohibits us from displaying prices** in the exhibit. A price list will be available online.

The Show Chair has sole discretion to accept or reject submissions.



PREPARING FOR HANGING

Hanging Requirements

Artwork must be wired and properly framed or have finished edges with flat mountings (D-ring and wire).

Prohibited Hanging Methods are methods that will either damage the wall or not hang safely. They include screw eyes, sawtooth hangers, poster frames, or Lucite clip frames. **They will NOT be accepted.**

Labeling

Label the back of the artwork with your **name, phone number, and title of the piece.**

ADMIN

Insurance

Artists are responsible for insuring their work.

LAA, City of Livermore, or Livermore Library are **not liable** for loss or damage during handling or exhibition.

Sales

A **20% commission** on all sales will go to LAA.

Display Duration: Artwork must remain on display for the entire show.

If sold, the artwork will be given to the buyer on **October 31**, unless other arrangements for delivery are made.
