August Sermon Series: Questions Jesus Asked

We often think of Jesus as having the answers for our lives, and typically he does. But we sometimes forget that Jesus also asked questions. In fact, he asked a lot of questions! Estimates of how many vary because of translations, duplicates in the Gospels, and the absence of punctuation in the original manuscripts, but it seems he asked around 150-300+ questions. The crazier thing? It appears he only answers three or four questions that he's asked.

I guess that this is because Jesus knew something that many of the great thinkers since him have realized also, that questioning is the greatest form of learning. Jesus used asking questions as a way to make people ponder, wrestle, and test their assumptions and beliefs. While he was asking questions, he was using them to teach.

And so, over the month of August we're going to look at five questions that Jesus asked in scripture:

"Why are you so afraid?"

"What do you want me to do for you?"

"Do you want to be made well?"

"Who do you say that I am?"

"Do you love me?"

What can we learn from these questions? What is Jesus asking of us? What is Jesus trying to teach us in asking these questions? How do these questions shape how we live as Christians today? I hope we're going to discover some of these answers together over the month of August. And I hope that in the process, we might learn to ask some questions as well.

I can't wait to worship with everyone on Sunday! I hope to see you there! And bring someone with you!



Registration

Disciple Bible Study (Fast Track) is a 24 week study divided into 2, 12-week sessions.
