The Lathim-Greer-Foshee Scholarship of St. Paul United Methodist Church

Kathryn L. Lathim Scholarship Fund - Mary Alice Greer Trust – Marguerite & Vernon L. Foshee Scholarship Endowment

St. Paul United Methodist Church has been generously endowed by church members who have, through gifts and memorials, established a scholarship fund that provides financial resources to be awarded to full-time students each year. The value of each scholarship will vary according to the returns on the invested funds and the number of qualified applicants.

Application Procedure

1. Applications will become available at the beginning of January during the year of application. Applications may be picked up at the church office or may be acquired from the church website.
2. Completed applications, current school transcript(s), letters of recommendation and a photo must be returned to the Scholarship Committee at the St. Paul UMC office by **March 1st**. Please check with the church office to verify that your application has been received by the church Administrative Assistant. It's preferred that applications be typed. Additional paper may be used if more room is needed for any responses. It's most important that your responses are detailed and complete to help the Scholarship Committee better know you. Any questions should be directed to the Scholarship Committee through the Church office.
3. After reviewing all applications, the Scholarship Committee will contact all applicants by mail. The scholarship recipients will be invited to the presentation of awards during a worship service in May. Recipients are expected to attend this presentation. If unable to attend, the student must contact the chairperson of the Scholarship Committee prior to the awards service.
4. This application is for one academic school year; however, a student may reapply in the following years if qualifications are met. Students may only receive a total of four scholarships.

Qualifications

1. Be enrolled at an accredited institution.
2. Be an incoming freshman or an ongoing student.

Preferences

1. Current Members of St. Paul United Methodist Church.
2. Enrolled at an institution that is accredited by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education or Oklahoma City University.
3. Have and maintain at least a 3.0 GPA.
4. Demonstrate personal character reflecting Christian principles.
5. Demonstrating a plan to return to Muskogee following graduation

Disbursement Procedure

The scholarship is awarded in two parts. The first half is disbursed in the fall semester and the second half in the spring semester, after proof of enrollment is given to the church.

The funds will be given to the student from St. Paul UMC.

If the applicant chooses to withdraw or withdraws for other reasons from the institution, prior to completion of the semester, funds should be returned to the Scholarship Fund of St. Paul UMC.
