Forward Bay Park

1. Pick a bay preferably on the right as it will be easier to get into. If you pick one on the left you will have to check it's safe and swing out onto the opposite side of the road before getting your reference and pulling into the bay.
2. Get your reference, which is the line closest to you of the bay you wish to park in being around half way between the middle of the window and the wing mirror on the driver side window. (This will need to be adjusted if you're pulling into a bay on the left or if your seat position is very different to mine)
3. Check it's clear all around and then move the car slowly and full lock to the right (or left). (pulling in on the right) Take off some steering if you're coming in too close to the car/line on your right. If you are coming in too close to the car on the left you will have to stop and reverse a little before continuing to pull in forward.
4. Make sure you're not touching any lines and your back end is in the box.
