Left reverse around the corner

1 : pull up just past the corner you want to reverse around, make sure you've looked into the road first and checked for obstructions and indicate after the road if needed. All round observations and reverse back until the back door handle (in the blind spot mirror) gets in line with the last straight paving stone. You want to see the car and curb the same distance and just as the curb starts to disappear around the corner and you can see the space between the car and curb getting bigger you'll need to stop.

2 : check all round, especially over the right as the car swings out onto the other side of the road. Steer one full circle to the left. You will have to keep an eye on the curb in relation to the car because you may need to 'wiggle' it a little by taking some off or putting more on with the steering wheel. Remember you are steering the way you want the car to go, you don't steer opposite in reverse.

3 : once you're in the new road and straight then you can straighten the wheel and move forward to the junction safely. Remember to always look behind you while doing this manoeuvre as you are reversing into oncoming traffic.

<u>Remember</u>

If any other vehicles or pedestrians come towards you from any direction you should stop and let them get out of the way before continuing. If someone comes up from behind you while reversing around the corner then wait a second, if they stop behind you then move out of their way.
