



Where does OpenAI stand on GPT and copyright

In the user policy, OpenAI recognises that the copyright for the text generated by AI belongs to the person who developed the prompt that led the AI to generate that response. OpenAI also recognises that limited prompts may generate content that is similar or identical between users. When considering the complex requirements of academic assignments, such as essays or case studies, and when applying specific AI techniques that you will learn from this guide, it becomes impossible for the AI to generate similar content between users.

What can this guide teach me?

Firstly, we aim to teach you the basics of how Al generates text and how it gets detected by software or/and humans. 
Next, you'll learn the fundamental principles of academic writing and critical analysis in a simple and easy way. We have lots of practical examples, making this learning experience fun and engaging.
