As the project lead for the OJJDP Opioid Affected Youth Initiative over the past 3 years, I had the opportunity to witness firsthand the value and impact of the Future Leaders Program during the planning and implementation of the grant award period. From all indications, the program made a remarkable and positive impact on students and families at John F. Kennedy High School, San Fernando High School, Patrick Henry Middle School, and Olive Vista Middle School, as well as on students associated with other community-based organizations.

The program was seamlessly integrated into support services for students dealing with substance use and behavioral challenges. Through weekly sessions, students participating in the 10-week program developed critical skills to reduce their substance use.
