



Tobogganing Trip

Saturday-Sunday, 01/21-01/22/2023

What: Troop 33 will be staying overnight at Auburn Lodge at Camp Chief Little Turtle and then traveling to Pokagon State Park for tobogganing fun.

When: Scouts will leave from the Environmental Center at 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, January 21. We will return around 1:30 p.m. on Sunday, January 22.

Where: CCLT/Pokagon | 2282 W 500 S, Pleasant Lake/450 Lane 100 Lake James, Angola.

Cost: The cost of this weekend is \$25, which includes fees for tobogganing, State park entrance fee, rental of the lodge, and meals.

Details: Scouts should eat dinner beforehand. We will stay overnight at CCLT, where we will have a cracker barrel and enjoy fellowship time. We will then have breakfast and pack up to be at the toboggan run by 10:00 a.m. We will hopefully enjoy 2 hours of sledding before heading back to Fort Wayne. Scouts will have a packed lunch in the car on the way back to the Environmental Center. Bring sleeping bag and pillow, toiletries, mess kit, water bottle, small games/cards for fellowship, and any required medications in original containers. Scouts must wear Field uniform for travel but may dress in layers for the tobogganing.

Rules for the toboggan run: Dress for the weather. Gloves must be worn when on the sleds. There will be a maximum of 4 people per sled. No cameras or video equipment are allowed while on the sled.
