The following is the information for the RGVCA Meet of Champions. The Meet is scheduled for Friday-Saturday, March 21 and 22, 2025. As voted and approved by RGVCA Member Head Track & Field Coaches the meet will be as follows:

- The prelims will host the top 32 performers of every event except the 3200m, 1600m and 800m.
- **THE TOP 32 PER EVENT WILL BE COMPILED AND POSTED BY MARCH 13, 2025.**
- The 3200m, 1600m and 800m will be a final event of two heats on Saturday.
- All other running event finals will consist of the preliminary heat winners and the next top 4 times.
- All horizontal field event participants will have 3 attempts in the preliminary round and the top 8 will advance to the finals.
- All vertical events, the top 8 finishers will advance to the finals.
- **We are asking that if your athlete is a top 32 finisher in an event and will not compete in the Meet of Champions to inform Coach JC Ramirez no later than Tuesday March 18.** All those that qualify must submit their entries by Thursday March 20, 2025 at 7:00 pm. **An invoice for all participants will be sent to each qualifier's school.** The Preliminary Meets for the Girls will be held at Weslaco's Bobby Lackey Stadium, and the Preliminary Meet for the Boys will be held at Boggus Stadium in Harlingen, TX on Friday March 21. The Finals will be held at Bobby Lackey Stadium in Weslaco on Saturday, March 22, 2025.

Fees for the Meet of Champions are as follow:

- \$10 per Athlete per Event
- \$40 per Relay

All Head Track Coaches must be a member of the RGVCA to be able to participate in the Meet of Champions.

What's New

Line 3a has been modified to clarify how a disregarded entity completes this line. An LLC that is a disregarded entity should check the appropriate box for the tax classification of its owner. Otherwise, it should check the "LLC" box and enter its appropriate tax classification.

New line 3b has been added to this form. A flow-through entity is required to complete this line to indicate that it has direct or indirect foreign partners, owners, or beneficiaries when it provides the Form W-9 to another flow-through entity in which it has an ownership interest. This change is intended to provide a flow-through entity with information regarding the status of its indirect foreign partners, owners, or beneficiaries, so that it can satisfy any applicable reporting requirements. For example, a partnership that has any indirect foreign partners may be required to complete Schedules K-2 and K-3. See the Partnership Instructions for Schedules K-2 and K-3 (Form 1065).
