

TAYLORED TALK a message for His people

CATCHERS OF PEOPLE

First century Palestine was known for agriculture, farming, and fishing. Hence, Jesus used the metaphorical images (fig tree, lost sheep, and fishing) when speaking and sharing parables. According to Matthew, Jesus meets and calls Peter, Andrew, James, and John while they are fishing. There are no formal introductions. Matthew 4:19 states, *And he said to them, "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men."* Christ issues this invitation to be His disciples with three explicit expectations:

- Follow Christ
- · Be formed by Christ
- Fishers for Christ

The Gospel of Luke provides some additional details about the disciples' call. The disciples were frustrated because they had fished all night and caught nothing. Jesus shows up in the early morning after their "shift" is over and as they are washing their nets. Jesus steps into Simon's boat and asks him to move the boat from the shore into the Sea of Galilee. After teaching the Word, Christ tells Simon to "Launch out into the deep and cast your nets for a catch." (Luke 5:4). Surprisingly to Simon, James, John, and others, they catch an abundance of fish after a long night of frustration and hard work that yielded no fish.

Next, Jesus explains their job description as His disciples. "And Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men." And when they had brought their boats to land, they left everything and followed him". (Luke 5:10 – 11[a]). Christ explicitly states that His disciples are to be CATCHERS OF PEOPLE. After Jesus' resurrection, He reminds His disciples of our marching orders:

- "Be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth" - Acts 1:8
- "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in [b] the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit," Matthew 28:19

Jesus is consistently clear to His followers and His church, we are called to be catchers of people. Daily, we should put on the armor of God and fish for people. Let's win souls for the Christ who died for our souls to be saved! Shifting Gears,


