**STATUS:** Full-Time (Exempt) **Primary Responsibilities & Duties:** 

- 1. Oversee the Children, Youth, and Young Adult Ministries at Antioch Baptist Church to include the functional areas of Children, Youth, and Young Adults, from birth to 24-year-old.
- Recruit, develop, and train volunteer servant Team Leaders for each of the mentioned ministries. Lead in the recruitment and development of the servant volunteers within each ministry.
- 3. Responsible for overseeing Children, Youth, and Young Adult Sunday School and Bible Studies.
- 4. Lead in the development and planning of Youth and Children Ministries, including Vacation Bible School, AWANA, and growth programs for Young Adult spiritual growth.
- 5. Develop relationships with parents of Youth and Children Ministry participants to effectively address the spiritual needs and growing concerns of the Youth and Children Ministry population.
- 6. Ensure compliance with all Child Safety and Assurance policies (for self, ministry leaders, and participants).
- 7. Provide ministry and program recommendations to the Pastor for the future of the Youth and Children Ministry.
- 8. Provide mission opportunities for the Youth and Children Ministry participants.
- 9. Other duties and responsibilities as assigned.

## Qualification

The Director of Youth and Children Ministries must fully agree with the Antioch Baptist Church's doctrinal statement and Articles of Faith. A degreed Seminary person with three to five years of ministry experience in related areas of ministry is preferred. In addition, the Director must have professed their faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and has a track record of faithful service to the Lord Jesus Christ through the church.
