Session Introduction

In this session we will discuss mans most innate desire which is to be significant and to determine his purpose and meaning in life

Defining the Terms

- Purpose: The object toward which one strives or for which something exists; an aim or goal
- Meaning: The core of whatever we do. It is only through meanings that we make sense of our existence. In life we find meaning through a sense of purpose which makes life worthwhile

The Problem

- Some men are eager for the spoils of this life, pursue significance by gratifying only their own ambitions, others, trained by the Scriptures, find it by obeying God.
- The difference in the two is in how they go about satisfying the need to be significant.

Do you really know:

Who you are ?Why do you exist?

Finding It

- Answering the question "Who am I?" and "Why do I exist?" determines how we pursue our significance.
- Answering the above questions divides men succinctly into two groups: those who pursue significance in appropriate ways and those who pursue significance in inappropriate ways. Our desire to satisfy this need can take us close to or far away from the things of God.
- Jesus said, "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing" (John 15:5)

Inappropriate Ways of Finding It

- Fame: Memories are short. When we try to answer the question "Who am I?" in terms of our fame and worldly accomplishment, we select an identity that will fade like sun-bleached furniture.
- Possessions: We all have unsatisfied Eyes! When possessions and money become a surrogate for our real identity, who we are is tied to things that rust and rot away.

POWER: WHAT'S HIS NAME AGAIN?

- The ability to control people, the ability to influence the big decisions, the ability to change the course of history these have been chief ways of satisfying a man's need to be significant from the earliest days of recorded history.
- The thrill of closing the big deal, the power to allocate massive resources to a project, the ability to persuade a prospect to buy your product even at higher prices than your competitors' these accomplishments are intoxicating and give the aura of power. We can begin to believe we have special abilities mere mortals are not endowed with!
- "Enjoy your power while you can, because once you retire, they don't return your calls anymore."

Self-Gratification or God's Agenda?

- Our society as the scales have tipped toward individual rights and away from Judeo-Christian values has immersed itself in pursuit of self-gratifying activity. Focus on personal peace and affluence has largely replaced deeply held, self-sacrificing convictions (and the resulting community-building causes) that benefit the human condition.
- The difference between self-gratification and significance is found in the motive and attitude, not in the task. Two men working side by side in an office can fulfill the exact same job description, yet have entirely different impacts.
- "Does what I am about to do contribute to the welfare of others in a demonstration of faith, love, obedience, and service to Christ?"
- Can you think of anything worse than coming to the wrong conclusion about Christ?
