Is there a "margarine of error" for Butter?

Butter is a concentrated source of milk fat, mostly composed of saturated fat, made by churning cream from cows. Margarine is a highly processed food product, typically made from vegetable oils. In the past few decades, butter had been blamed for contributing to heart disease, due to its high saturated fat content. Now, it is considered healthy when used in moderation. Its health effects largely depend on the diet of the cows it comes from. Butter from grass-fed bovines is much more nutritious, especially for the heart. Unfortunately, most cows in the U.S. are primarily fed grain. One tablespoon packs in 100 calories and 11 grams of fat; but so does margarine. Butter is also high in cholesterol. Getting moderate amounts from the diet doesn't raise blood levels in most people, because the body compensates by producing less. The health benefits of margarine depend on what kind of vegetable oils it contains and how it is processed (look for olive oil). It is often rich in polyunsaturated fat, which may reduce the risk of heart problems. However, it often contains trans-fat, which has been linked to chronic health issues. When you shop, read the label – trans-fat-free margarines do exist.
