Back-to-School Health Tips

Many children are heading back to school this month. Transitioning from summer vacation to school can be tough to navigate. Use these back-to-school health tips to help prepare for a new school year.

1. **Practice getting back into routines.** Easing your child into a regular sleep schedule is important. Not having enough sleep can impede the learning process and make it difficult for your child to fully focus on what's being taught.
2. **Talk about the transition.** Take time to sit down with your child and discuss both what they're excited about, and what they're nervous about. Do more listening than problem-solving so you can fully understand and acknowledge how they're feeling.
3. **Make sure your child has had his or her annual physical and recommended vaccinations.** Over the years, the recommended vaccination schedule has changed due to more disease outbreaks in the U.S. Make sure your child starts the school year healthy and protected from vaccine-preventable diseases with a visit to his or her primary care provider before school starts.
4. **Make sure your child's nutrition needs are met.** This includes eating breakfast every day and making sure your child has a well-balanced lunch. Eating right will help your child focus and learn better during the school day.
5. **Talk to the teacher about any health concerns.** Many school-aged children have health conditions such as asthma that need to be managed throughout the school day. Make sure you talk to your child's teacher and to the school nurse so your child knows what to expect.
