Senior Options

Helps seniors maintain their independence and supports family members who are caring for an older loved one. Services include:

- Adult day care
- Emergency response systems
- Home-delivered meals
- Home care services
- Nutritional supplements, incontinence supplies, and durable medical equipment
- Transportation

Minor Home Repair

Ensures that older adults' homes are safe and secure. This might include:

- Minor plumbing
- Electrical, gas and furnace repairs
- Wheelchair and walker ramps
- Handrails and grab bars
- Pest control
- Moving assistance

Adult Protective Services

Provides assistance to older adults who are unable to protect themselves and are in danger of being mistreated. Interventions include, but are not limited to:

- Receiving reports of adult abuse, neglect or exploitation
- Investigating reports
- Case planning
- Monitoring and evaluation

Caregiver Support Program

Offers short-term support to non-paid caregivers of older adults aged 60+ and adult children aged 18-59 with disabilities who have a need for assistance. Program services include:

- Adult day services
- Caregiver counseling
- Durable medical equipment
- Incontinence supplies
- Institutional respite care

Kinship Support Program

Provides short-term assistance through various supplemental services to adults aged 55+ who are caring for minor children and are not the biological parents. Services include:

- Appliances
- Diapers
- Mattress sets
- Utility & rental assistance
