(In reference to son with autism)

- He's loving, funny, forgiving, tough
- He's taught me to appreciate small victories/growth
- Less talk, more showing
- Patience, repetition, structure, planning ahead
- It's an ongoing process of learning his potentials, barriers, who he is and what he wants to be
- Autism looks different than I thought it would
- Every child is an individual & is different
- It's an ongoing process of grief and acceptance
- There's so much I still don't know, can't plan for





- Being a professional didn't help me as much as I thought it would
- Advocating
- Trying again, starting new each day
- Medical, school, and social support is key

ADHD & WHAT I'VE LEARNED



(In reference to son with ADHD)

- He's funny, creative, feels deeply, enthusiastic, charming, tough
- He's quick to anger/frustration, struggles with self-esteem/comparison
- Responds poorly to yelling, punishment
- Needs a lot of bonding time for creating positivity
- Responds better to space, time, empathy, finding solutions together
- He's taught me to be more empathetic, understand behavior better
 - "the only thing that you can count on is that he'll be inconsistent
 - He often can'
- Every child is an individual & is different
- It's an ongoing process of grief and acceptance
- There's so much I still don't knows, can't plan for



ADHD & WHAT I'VE LEARNED

5Cs

- Self-Control: Learn to manage your own feelings first so you can act effectively and teach your child to do the same.
- Compassion: Meet your child where they are, not where you expect them to be.
- Collaboration: Work together with your child and other caregivers to find solutions to daily challenges instead of imposing rules on them.
- Consistency: Do what you say you will do—over and over again.
- Celebration: Acknowledge what's working and doing more of it, day after day after day
