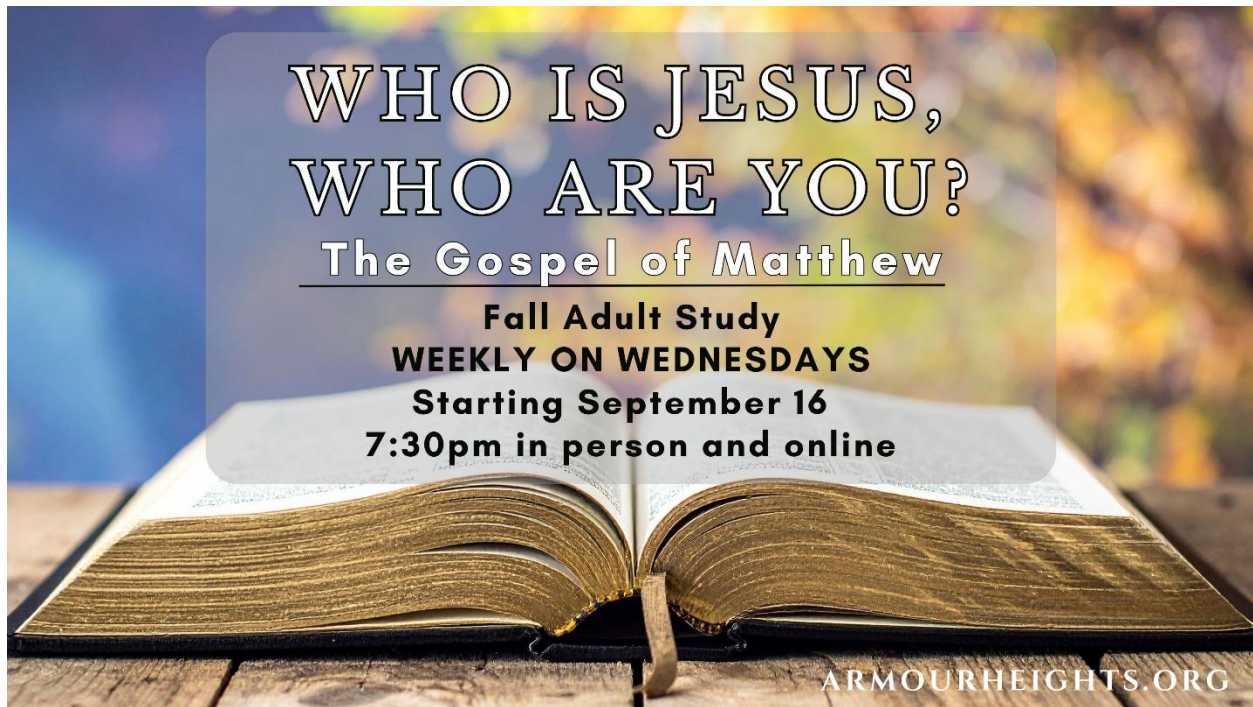




WHO IS JESUS, WHO ARE YOU?
