

Adam & Eve Art Project: ROCK ON!



Paint rocks for your own gardens or neighbourhoods with words that remind us how to live. When you see your rock, you'll remember that we all mess up sometimes and we all need God's love and forgiveness.

Supplies:

- Clean, dry rocks (at least 3" [7-8 cm] in diameter)
- Acrylic paints
- Paintbrushes
- Bowl of water
- Black permanent markers
- Other permanent markers (if using markers instead of acrylic paint)

Set Up:

1. Collect rocks, scrub off dirt, let them dry.
2. Place bowl of water on table.
3. Set out the paints and brushes.

Instructions:

Everybody does things wrong sometimes, right? We learn from the story of the Adam & Eve and the snake that we all need God's love and forgiveness. And the good news is that

God always loves us and always forgives us. Think of words that can describe the kinds of things God wants us to do in our lives. Ideas could include: forgive, care, pray, love, share, smile, etc.

Paint these kinds of words on your rocks to keep in your home or garden. The rocks will remind all who see them how to live, and when we see them, we'll remember that God loves and forgives us.

- 1. Take a clean rock and paint a word on it.**
- 2. Once the paint dries, outline your word in black permanent marker.**
- 3. Alternatively, use permanent markers to draw your word on your rock instead of acrylic paint.**

If you have more time . . .

Acrylic paint dries quickly. Paint the entire rock one colour first. Then after it dries, paint your words and designs on the rocks.
