

Advent Wreath Materials

Planter saucers (2)

1 x 10"

1 x 6"



Wet oasis (1 brick)



Floral tape (or any tape that will stay sticky when wet)



Candles (5)

- Advent candles are traditionally either purple or blue, sometimes with 1 pink candle for "joy"
- If you opt for 5 candles, then the Christ candle is traditionally white
 - You could get a block candle (one that's stout instead of slim)
- Get coloured candles or get all white candles and just tie ribbon or embroidery floss in purple/blue or pink around each candle

Evergreen boughs

- Any form of live evergreen you can get! Flower shops or hardware stores like Home Depot or Rona will have options at this time of year. Or, if you're able, cut some from your own property.

Other materials you'll want on hand:

- Glue gun
- Snips/pruning shears (for cutting boughs into smaller pieces)
- Knife (for cutting the wet oasis)
- Large bowl of water
- Platter to place your wreath on (optional)
