Damascus Road Project just celebrated 15 years of serving those victimized by sex trafficking and sexual exploitation in our own communities! As I look back over those 15 years, I am amazed at all that God has done with this ministry. I started out solo, volunteering with a missionary group overseas. Upon returning, I was compelled to share my experiences and new-found understanding anywhere I could. Fast forward, this tiny ministry that operated from the trunk of my car has evolved into an awesome family of about 40 volunteers serving nearly 700 clients! God is so good!

Our focus remains on bringing awareness through educating, restoring and empowering the abused, and advocating for the

prevention and abolition of trafficking and exploitation. In this report we thought we'd highlight some of the programs that we currently offer to our clients (Pages 9-18). While we still operate almost entirely with our amazing committed team of volunteers, I am so excited to share with you that after 15 years, Damascus Road Project has taken a big leap, and finally hired our first part-time staff members - including a survivor / former client! This is especially meaningful to all of us, as she brings so much wisdom and lived experience to our organization.

On a personal note, in April, 2024 my mom fell gravely ill. She spent 12 days in the ICU, followed by an extended hospital stay and a lengthy stay at a rehab facility. She nearly died more than once - but God! During the several weeks that I spent with my mom and family, we witnessed miracle after miracle. Prayer is powerful, and our volunteer family made sure we were prayed for and supported! My mom is alive today and back volunteering for Damascus Road Project every month! Her healing is on-going, but she is doing so well! I was able to share the stories of the miracles we witnessed with her healing at a recent Damascus' Road Project family dinner with clients. It is so inspirational for all of us to see God at work!

We are so blessed to belong to a supportive community that enables us to walk alongside each client on their journey to restoration. We are so grateful for each of you who continue down the path with us.


