- Ditch Mowing
 - SID 582 should mow their areas every 30 days.

 - Sunflowers on Fort need to be removed by the homeowner because that is part of the SID area, not homeowner property.

- Clean Ups

 - Has been completed.
 - Tree area by cell tower
 - Partially complete.
 - Cleaned branches and clutter; 50 feet.
 - Hope to do another section in the future.
- Fines
 - Due Delinquencies
 - Only five remaining.
 - Late process has been started. First warning letters have been sent
 - Ask mgmt. company for example letters so we're aware of what's going out.
 - Ask for monthly report.
 - Violations
 - New mgmt company has kept up to date with sending out letters.
 - Primarily trash cans left out, one trailer in driveway.
 - If not remedied, people will begin incurring fines daily.
- Front Area
 - We pay \$40 monthly for electric to light up sign.
 - o Paid for black mulch earlier in the year.

- Area is trimmed, but still many weeds in that area.
- Maintenance can be added to next budget.
- Water Retention
 - Areas are quite full with all the rain.
 - o Long term plan is to completely redo those in the spring. SID will clean out.
