Planned events for 2023

Budget

- Based on expected income and expenditures, we are only sitting with about \$400 in excess

- Also mentioned that we can submit a request to the SID to put signage along Tibbles to prevent parking on one side – emergency vehicle access – this was brought up as a concern from a neighbor
- Also mentioned that they can assist with legal action should any neighbors violate covenants like illegal dumping of yard waste
- A suggestion about putting pictures of houses online for the Christmas Lights Display and then sending out a ballot via email to the neighbors
- One present wanted a breakdown of the management fees \$110 was for website design, maintenance and upkeep, remaining was for office fees, mailings, etc.
