### 2025 RECAP

- A new AutoFry machine was added to the clubhouse - keeping fresh, hot favorites coming all season long — a real win on the back nine for the clubhouse.
- The pool was sandblasted and repainted, bringing it back to top form and making a splash with members.

### 2026 FLASH FORWARD

- Swimming lessons at the pool will be offered more frequently and will involve a more thorough and high skilled lesson plans.
