THE SYSTEMIC SHADOW ARCHETYPES

The Invisible Elephant — Disconnection & Isolation

- Represents missed human connection
- Symbolizes loneliness, invisibility, emotional neglect
- Walks through spaces unnoticed but felt by all

Teaches: The cost of invisibility, the need for presence and belonging



The Glass Birds — Technoference

- Pull attention upward and outward
- Reflect engineered distraction
- Scatter focus and fracture presence

Teaches: Digital interference, attention drift, loss of embodied connection

Glowfog / Mirror Moths / Home of Elsewhere

- Dopamine loops
- Digital identity splitting
- Escapism
- Dissociation through screens

Teaches: Awareness of systemic attention capture
