In order to apply, **you must have been a CSAR member for at least one calendar year**. The Awards Committee will be responsible for the application and award process. This fund was started with a donation from

Supreme Master TV and the funds raised via Cindy Corcoran's "Pink" Items raffle at the 2009 seminar in Ohio. These monies were designated specifically to start this fund in Carolyn's honor. Each year, we have several Pink Raffles at the CSAR Seminar. All money raised from the Pink Raffles is earmarked for the Scholarship Fund.

NOTE –The application deadline for 2025 will be **January 31st, 2025.** The application can be found on the following page along with the address to mail completed form. **Also note:** The recipient will need to register for the seminar when registration opens to secure their spot in the class they want. A code will be provided to the recipient for registration. CSAR pays for the registration. The Knapp Scholarship recipient's name is kept private and not published or announced except to the recipient.
